On the other hand, those who are too busy, or too lazy, or too indifferent, to give as much time as the plan calls for, could, at least, glance through the assigned books, and read some of the best chapters, and thus, in measure, follow along with the group, till, by and by, they might find themselves becoming more interested.

This plan is only a suggestion. Any pastor or teacher who would try out the plan should make his own schedule; for its success, in the last analysis, will depend on the conviction and earnestness with which the leader pushes it.
